Encouraged by the many enthusiastic reactions to our four preceding conferences in 1996, 1999, 2003 and 2007 we are pleased to announce the forthcoming fifth international conference on 'The (Non)Expression of Emotions in Health and Disease'.

Similar as the foregoing conferences, this three-day-conference again aims to offer a broad scope of topics related to the way people express their feelings and factors inhibiting the display of emotions. In addition, the psychological and physiological effects of expression and inhibition will be critically evaluated. The conference is of interest for behavioral scientists involved in fundamental research as well as for professionals active in clinical settings.
